The Venue

- Wheel chair accessible.
- Smoke- free.
- Light refreshments available for sale.
- Floor size 11m x 17m.

Cost

- *Competitors* - \$10 per event per competitor with a maximum of \$50 payable per competitor.
- *Spectators* - \$12 or \$10 concession on the day.

Billeting

- May be provided free to people who live outside Adelaide and who participate in the competition.

Details

- The competition will start at 2pm and finish at approx 5.00pm.
- The venue will be open from 1.00pm for competitor warm ups.
- Competitors can request via rainbow_ballroomdancers@hotmail.com to access their results from the judges scoring sheets.
- Throughout the event, spectators are encouraged to participate in social dances to allow competitors time for costume changes.

Public Transport

- Catch Glenelg tram to Stop 5 from the city.
- Catch Buses 210-218 to corner of Railway Terrace & Goodwood Road.

Sponsorship

- No commercial activities (outside of official sponsors) in or around the venue are permitted. This includes the distribution of brochures and placements of posters in and around the venue.
- Sponsorship welcomed. Please contact one of the Committee for details.

After Competition

- You are all **invited to stay on** for the after competition dance party which will run until 8pm. Food will be available.

Competition Rules

- All competitors must be 18 years or older to participate in this competition.
- All competition couples must be of the same sex (excluding Female Lead-Male Follow events).
- Entries must be received by **15 October 2010**.
- The organisers reserve the right to withdraw applications that do not adhere to the rules.
- The competition is open to all levels of dancing, from social beginner to amateurs and professionals.

- In principle, separate events for female and male couples are preferable. However, if the number of entrants is not adequate to support this, the organisers have the right to combine events.
- All adjudicators decisions are final.
- Lifts or any choreography that may endanger other couples are not permitted in any category. However, Cabaret entrants may perform any move, at their own risk.
- For all competition events and heats, the duration of the music shall be between 1 and 1½ minutes.

Graded Events

- A Grade: High level amateur to professional.
- B Grade: Intermediate standard.
- C Grade: Experienced social dancers.

Grading Heats

- There will be grading heats.
- Grading heats involve couples dancing all C grade specified dances to enable the judges to place each couple in the appropriate grade. Couples who enter A, B or C grades must be able and prepared to dance all four dances in their chosen style.
- These heats are specifically intended to check each couples' level for fair competition. Couples may be moved up or down from their chosen grade according to performance on the day.
- If the total number of couples is insufficient, the organisers have the right to combine grades.

Professional

- Cabaret events are open to professionals only. Programs should be around 3 minutes long. Lifts etc performed at own risk. Couples will need to supply their own music on CD.

Novice Events

- For those who have not competed before or who have not won 1st place in this event previously.

Singles Events

- Are for those who don't have a dance partner. The entrant may borrow a partner of the same sex. Only the single entrant will be judged and not the couple. Coach/student partners are encouraged.

Novelty Event

- There will be a medal awarded for best costumed competitors, and for best costume among spectators. Festive clothing must cover genitals at all times.

Community Event – no entry fee required

- For competitors or spectators to compete for the most out of time waltz. This is a fun event.
